

Sanitation Program Improvements Coming Soon!!!



The Borough of Lansdowne is excited to introduce improvements to curbside trash and recycling services beginning on January 7th, 2019. Program improvements include new trash carts and automatic lifters on our trucks for safe and efficient trash pick-up. Modernizing our program offers these benefits:

1. Improved safety of our Sanitation Crews
2. Reduced street litter and trash accumulation
3. Convenient and comprehensive trash, recycling and yard waste services for our customers
4. Maintaining affordable trash bills despite significant increases in disposal and recycling costs.

Collection Services (What's New???)

- 1. New Carts:** A 65-gallon, brown, trash cart with wheels will be delivered to your residence before January 7th (at no cost to you). The new can/cart is for trash only and not to be used for yard waste or other purposes. *Note: Continue to use your green barrel for mixed recyclables.*
- 2. Curbside Collection:** Rear-yard collection transitions to curbside-only collection. Please pitch in and place your new trash cart at the curb as follows:
 - Wheels facing the street



- 3. Up to two (2) non-refrigerant containing bulk items will be collected on the weekly collection day:** Two bulk-item per week can be set at the curbside on your regularly scheduled trash day provided it is less than 50 pounds (e.g. chairs) and is easily lifted by one person. *Note: Large bulk-items including freon-on containing appliances, mattresses and couches will not be collected on regular trash day.* Bulk items will continue to require registration by calling (610) 622-6318

Schedule (What's new???)

In December a collection schedule will be provided to your residence and posted on the Borough website to confirm the trash collection day in your neighborhood. The schedule works like this:

1. Curbside Trash (T), Bulk Items (B), and Recyclables (R) are collected once per week. Your collection day depends on where you live (Refer the map and schedule below).
 - **Non-Holiday Schedule:** Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays
 - **Holiday-Schedule:** Varies based on holiday.

Schedule (What stays the same???)

1. Yard Waste (YW) is still collected once per week on Wednesday. Yard Waste is not collected on Holiday weeks.

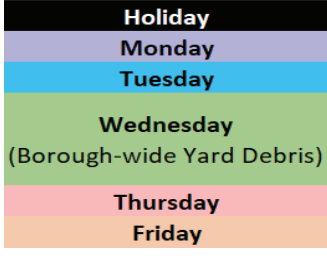
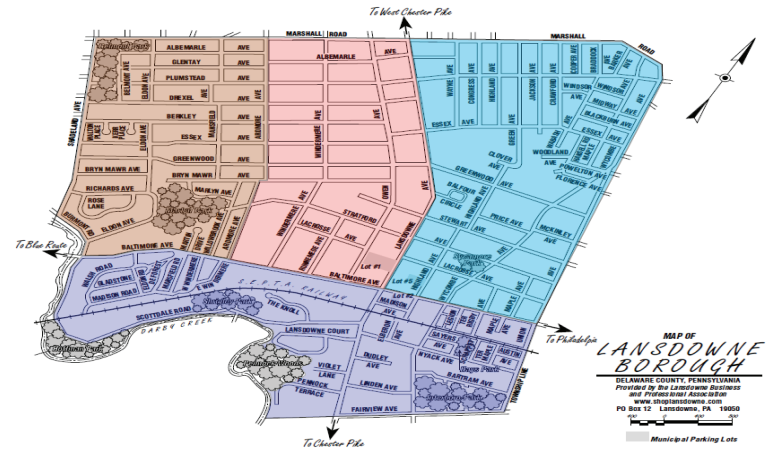

Questions & Answers

Q: Why change the collection program?

A: The Borough was recently notified of significant increases in landfill fees and recycling fees. Modernizing the program to be safer and efficient lowers operating costs to provide economically sustainable collection at a fair price to our residents.

- Delaware County Solid Waste Authority (DCSWA) disposal fees were \$15 per ton in 2009, increased to \$33/ton, and will increase to \$54 per ton 2019.
- At one time mixed recyclables generated about \$20 per ton that was put back in the Sanitation program to keep costs and trash bills affordable. Currently, mixed recyclable markets are down and the Borough pay roughly \$55 per ton to process recyclables.

Q: What do I need to do differently on trash day?

A: Use the cart provided (not your old container). Place the cart at the curbside. Up to two (2) non-refrigerant containing bulk items will be collected on the weekly collection day.

Q: How has bulk-item collection service change?

A: We've made it easier. Now you can place smaller bulk-items at the curb each week. Collection of Freon-containing items (e.g., air conditioners and refrigerators) must be scheduled with the Borough. Please refer to the Borough website and complete the bulk pickup form.

Q: What if I have extra trash that won't fit in my Borough-provided trash cart?

A: Do not place other carts, plastic containers, or metal cans at the curb. If the new, brown, 65-gallon trash container does not provide sufficient volume for trash residents may place up to two additional trash bags (each weighing less than 40 lbs.) Immediately adjacent to the brown container. No un-bagged trash will be collected.

Q: Where do I place my trash cart if I live in an alley?

A: Residents who currently place trash in private alleys *behind-the-house* shall continue to do. The Borough will provide specific cart placement instructions to residents with alley collection as needed.
