Duties:

Education:

The new Director will possess a Master's Degree in Library Science with a minimum of 2 years of supervisory and program experience in a public library or commensurate experience reflecting supervisory and public programming responsibilities and engagement. Grant-writing and fiscal planning experience are a plus. Excellent interpersonal and organizational skills are required.
