

Help Lansdowne Borough Clean Up Our Streams and Creeks

It's Part of Your Job!

As a contactor performing work in the Borough, you can make a difference in the condition of our local streams and waterways:

1. Never allow chemicals, detergents, construction materials or anything other than water to enter the Borough's storm sewer system. For example, if you are doing concrete work, do not pour extra material into the storm drain or into the street. These materials eventually enter our streams.
2. Keep your worksite neat. Loose trash, gravel, or other building materials can find their way into the street and eventually be washed into the storm sewer system.
3. Don't track mud into the street. If you are parking your job vehicles on a muddy surface, make sure you take measures to keep the mud at the jobsite and not track it onto Borough streets.

Borough Code Enforcement Officers will be inspecting your job to ensure that you are taking appropriate measures to prevent unwanted materials from entering the Borough's storm sewer system. Don't get caught! Infractions can result in citations and fines. Thank you for your cooperation!
