Accepting rice, cereal, oatmeal, cereal bars, flour, powdered/evaporated/boxed milk, oil, sugar, salt, instant coffee, peanut butter, canned fish and meats, canned vegetables, and dry or canned beans: black, pinto, kidney. Pasta, sauce, canned soup, tea, sugar, honey, applesauce, juice, pudding, condiments. Cleaning products, laundry items, body wash, deodorant, bar soap, toothpaste, feminine hygiene products, diapers and wipes. Some suggested culturally specific items include: Raman, jasmine or parboiled rice, Semolina (Sooji) flour, Maseca (tortilla flour) and Fufu.
