

## RESOLUTION NO. 2021-29

### **A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION 2022 MULTIMODAL TRANSPORTATION FUND GRANT REQUEST, DESIGNATING A BOROUGH OFFICIAL TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS AND AGREEMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE REQUESTED GRANT AND ASSIST IN OBTAINING THE REQUESTED GRANT, AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MISCELLANEOUS MATTERS**

WHEREAS, the Lansdowne Borough Council has determined to request a grant under the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation 2022 Multimodal Transportation Fund (the "MTF Grant Program") for financial assistance for the installation of Phase I of the Lansdowne Borough Bike Plan (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the MTF Grant Program requirements, the Council desires to declare its approval of the grant request for Project and designate a Borough official authorized to execute documents and agreements and assist in obtaining the requested grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Lansdowne Borough Council as follows:

1. The Borough is authorized to request, and does hereby request, a MTF grant of One hundred forty-two thousand nine hundred and forty three dollars and 00/100 cents (\$142,943) from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for the Project.
2. Craig Totaro, Borough Manager, is designated as the official (the "Designated Official") to execute all documents and agreement between Lansdowne Borough and the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.
3. The Designated Official is authorized to send the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation a letter of commitment confirming the Borough's commitment to provide matching funds of \$42,883 for the Project, as well as any additional funds necessary to complete the Project beyond those provided by the MTF Grant. Any required funding match or project overages shall issue from the Borough General Fund.
4. The provisions of this Resolution shall be severable, and if any of the provisions hereof shall be found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in effect.
5. This Resolution shall be effective immediately and shall remain in effect until modified or repealed by further Resolution of the Lansdowne Borough Council.
