A RESOLUTION HONORING THE LIFE AND SERVICE OF STATE REPRESENTATIVE

NICHOLAS MICOZZIE

Whereas, Nicholas Micozzie served in the Pennsylvania House of Representatives for the 163rd District, which included the Borough of Lansdowne, during his 35 year tenure as a Representative; and,

Whereas, the Borough of Lansdowne recognizes the tireless efforts of Representative Nicholas Micozzie in advocating for and securing funding for various projects both public and private in Lansdowne Borough and the Greater Lansdowne Community; and,

Whereas, the Borough of Lansdowne wishes to recognize the tireless work of Nicholas Micozzie on behalf of the residents of Lansdowne in securing aid from the State of Pennsylvania in the restoration of Hoffman Park and the Baltimore Pike Bridge after the devastation of Hurricane Floyd; and,

Whereas, the Borough of Lansdowne wishes to honor the service of Nicholas Micozzie as a Korean War Veteran and in his service as a Representative secured funding to restore the World War Monument and World War II Monument at Penn Wood High School; and,

Whereas, the Borough of Lansdowne notes that Representative Nicholas Micozzie advocated for and secured funding for the Darby Creek Greenway Trail through Hoffman Park; and,

Whereas, the Borough of Lansdowne observes that Representative Nicholas Micozzie assisted in the purchase of the Sycamore Park property and secured funding to purchase and clear the property to create a Community Park to preserve the 300 year old Sycamore tree; and,

Whereas, the Borough of Lansdowne recognizes the sacrifices of the Micozzie family for the hours spent in service by Representative Micozzie for the community of Lansdowne and the residents of Lansdowne; and,

Whereas, numerous residents in the Borough of Lansdowne benefited from and were touched by the public service of Representative Nicholas Micozzie during his service of 35 years in the State House of Representatives; and;

Whereas, the Borough of Lansdowne lost a friend when Representative Nicholas Micozzie passed on July 28th, 2020 at the age of 89 and many in Lansdowne mourn his loss;

Now, Therefore, be it Resolved that the Borough of Lansdowne does hereby recognize and honor the esteemed former State Representative for Lansdowne, Nicholas Anthony Micozzie and wish to acknowledge the loss of a champion of the Greater Lansdowne community and Delaware County with the passing of Nicholas Micozzie.
